### Uniform for our next school year

We are only able to accept uniform orders online at this time – look out for the form on Microsoft Teams or, by email, if you request this from Mrs. Orhan. **All orders must be paid for in advance**. All uniform items can be collected on September 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> when school reopens to pupils as detailed earlier. A reminder that all our Year 6 pupils will return to school wearing our school tie and a blazer – please make sure you organise blazers in plenty of time, as these items will now be in huge demand across the UK! The ties are only available via school and these are the 'clip-on' version – no other ties are permitted.

### Year 6 – End of Year Celebrations

Regrettably, we are not permitted to hold our planned celebrations to mark the end of our Year 6 pupils' time at Copperfield in the usual way – I am sure you will all understand this, and will support us with discussing this with your children – especially important if they are not accessing education at this time.

Over the next few weeks we will be working with our Year 6 pupils <u>onsite and at home</u> in creating their own virtual yearbook page – we will be in touch with exactly what we need you to help them to do next week.
