


And Tango makes Three, Justin Richardson and Peter Parnell

This book is based on the true life story of Roy and Silo, two penguins at the Central Park Zoo in New York City.




Prince Henry, Olly Pike

Prince Henry has to find someone to marry. The story follows Henry in his fairy tale kingdom where certain laws apply when it comes to choosing who you can spend your life with.




This Day in June, Gayle E. Pitman


Julian is a Mermaid, Jessica Love
