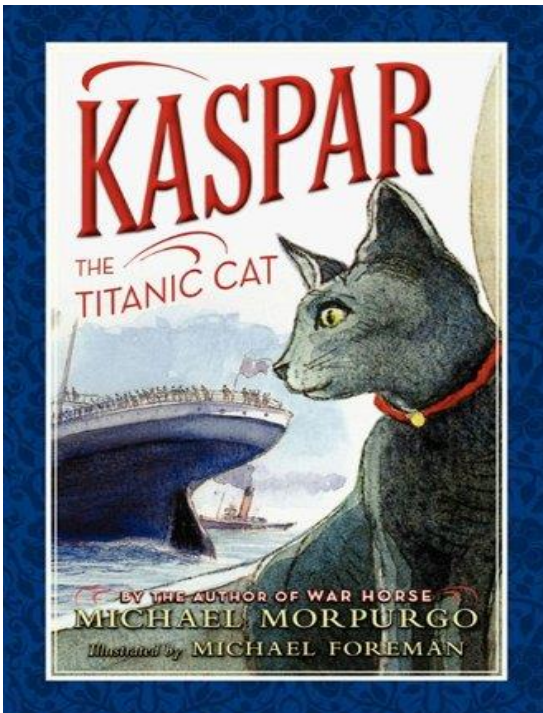


## Summer Term 1 Reading List
