Marking Guidance

<p>All adult marking is to be completed in green or pink, no other colours are to be used. GREEN for GREAT and PINK for THINK.</p> <p><u>There is no expectation that this will be in every child's book daily. However, can be used whenever necessary.</u></p>	
<p>Children to edit and improve using purple pen or purple coloured pencil. PURPLE for POLISHING.</p> <p>This may be when editing or when completing a next step task. Continue to use 'Next step' challenges when suitable e.g. early morning work etc.</p>	
<p>Try to complete as much 'live marking' as possible. A written record is not required - VF (Verbal Feedback) to be recorded on the LO.</p>	<p>VF</p>
<p>LOs should be highlighted green when met, any missed LOs should be highlighted in pink.</p> <p>This must be completed daily for each pupil (AFL).</p>	
<p>Adults to scribe pupils work in green, as needed, when working with a pupil/group.</p>	
<p>LOs should be annotated to identify level of support. SW - Shared writing GW - Group work PW - Paired work CT - worked with class teacher TA - worked with teaching assistant CS/HLTA - lesson was taught by a cover supervisor or HLTA.</p> <p><u>No annotation indicates child worked wholly independently.</u></p>	



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
